

EDIBLE CANNABIS SAFETY GUIDE

NEW TO EDIBLES?

Even if you're an experienced cannabis smoker, edibles can make you feel like a total amateur if you're not careful. It will affect you differently than when you smoke. We've all heard party pot brownie horror stories so here's a few guidelines when trying cannabis edibles to make your experience awesome, not "holy crap where did my face go"?

HOW MUCH SHOULD YOU TAKE?

Eating the entire edible is not a smart way to find your dose. Low and slow is the golden rule. Not all edibles on the market are divided into doses but generally, a standard dose is 10 mg THC. Most new cannabis edible users feel the effect with as little as 5 mg THC. We recommend starting with a 5 - 10 mg THC dose, even if you do already smoke or vape.

BE PATIENT Cannabis edibles can take up to 90 minutes to kick in. Don't consider taking another serving until 90 minutes has passed.



READ THE LABEL This step could make or break your experience. Make sure you read the label and know exactly how much to consume to achieve the dose you're going for. Have food allergies? Always check out the list of ingredients.



IT LASTS A LONG TIME The effects of a cannabis edible typically last 4 - 8 hours. Make sure you don't have any responsibilities or commitments within 12 hours of eating a cannabis edible.



DRIVING WHILE HIGH IS A DUI Cannabis edibles alter your reaction time and mental perception. Do not operate a motor vehicle if you're under the influence of cannabis



KEEP IT AWAY FROM KIDS AND PETS Edibles are often candies or cookies, tempting for children and pets. Do not leave your edibles unattended. Always store your edibles in a locked, secure space.



CANNABIS AND ALCOHOL DON'T MIX Consuming cannabis with alcohol or other controlled substances can alter its effects. Don't consume cannabis or cannabis products while under the influence of alcohol or controlled substances.
